Apparently I've lost your phone number.

RE the Holiness publications published in Chicago: Try searching online for scans of something called the Ayer Directory. If you can't find it anywhere else, the Library of Congress has a scan of the 1898 edition on their website. It's called a newspaper directory, but it also picks up other serial publications.

However, I think I may have found something. In the 1900 census, I find a Joseph C. Fisher in LaGrange, Indiana. (Northeast Indiana, very close to the Michigan border.) He's the same age, born in England and married to an Alice J. Fisher. In 1900 he's working as a gardener. The 1910 census is more interesting. They're still in the same place. Both of them are listed as having been married twice. Also, he is working as a minister.

According to the Indiana death records, this Joseph Fisher died April 6, 1917. I have ordered the microfilm of the Lagrange newspaper for an obituary.
